The CPO/SVP is responsible for developing and executing a philanthropic plan in support of ThedaCare's population health strategy. This will include leading, planning, organizing, staffing, and directing all aspects of philanthropic development for ThedaCare. The CPO/SVP works with internal and external stakeholders to build and sustain a comprehensive fund development program that advances the long-term strategic priorities of ThedaCare. The position will also

provide executive leadership and facilitation to the foundation board of directors, subcommittees, and advisory structure to maintain strong advocacy and fundraising



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efforts in local communities throughout the service region.

Key Accountabilities

- A leader who demonstrates and promotes ThedaCare's *life*inspired movement and culture through words and actions.
- Oversees administration of the foundation's \$60M+ asset base to ensure operational and fiscal integrity, governance, and legal compliance in accordance with 501c3 status.
- Serves as the principal architect and owner of the foundation's comprehensive fundraising program as it relates to the industry standard donor cycle.
- Serves as chief liaison, in partnership with the Board President and President and CEO, to the Foundation Board, subcommittees, and volunteer advisory structure, including plan development, communications, education, board appointments, recruitment and evaluation.
- Leads the foundation team members to align activities with ThedaCare needs, both current and projected.
- Establishes goals, objectives, strategies, and the assessment of outcomes for development actions to ensure performance and grow sustained giving.
- Maintains a dynamic portfolio of community leaders and high net-worth prospects to secure major, capital, and planned gifts, as well as advanced annual gifts and endowment support.
- Provides strategic direction and management oversight to all foundation's public relations, marketing, and communication in partnership with organizational brand strategy.
- Represents the foundation with key constituents and stakeholders to advance ThedaCare's mission and promote philanthropy.
