Position Summary

The Associate Director of Prospect Research will conduct in-depth analysis of biographical, business, personal, and financial information on current and prospective corporations, foundations and individual prospects. Will fulfill timely research requests by providing thorough and actionable summaries that advance effective relationship building. Additionally, this position will work closely with the foundation team to continually grow the prospect identification process, documentation and records database.

Specific Responsibilities

- Using a variety of research tools, drive the prospect identification and qualification process by providing comprehensive screening and research, evaluation of new potential prospects and opportunities to deepen relationships with existing donors in accordance with established methodologies.
- Research financial opportunities with corporations and private foundations.
- Assist with research, management and maintenance of prospect data

to ensure accuracy and accessibility.

- Accurately record changes in prospect data in the database as needed.
- Read contact reports and news articles to keep appraised of development activity as it relates to research, prospects and grants.



- Help create detailed prospect profiles for fundraising related meetings and functions.
- Assist with maintenance of research tools and area specific methodologies.
- Help to define, refine and manage processes associated with prospect management
- Assist in building and evaluating portfolios.
- Implementing methods that drive portfolio activity.
- Help identify changes to improve the overall Prospect Research program.
- Collaborate with the foundation team to advance donor engagement.
